

AG BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES LOAN PROGRAM

The purpose of the Ag Best Management Practices (AgBMP) Loan Program is for local units of government to assist borrowers who implement ag best management activities which prevent or mitigate nonpoint source water pollution.

The AgBMP Loan Program is administered by the MN Department of Agriculture and was created in 1994 by the MN Legislature and is funded with federal Environmental Protection Agency money.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES:

Facilities/Fixtures, i.e., Ag waste management systems, waterways, terraces and sediment control basins

Septic Systems, replacement of FAILING systems only

Equipment, i.e., minimum tillage equipment

The AgBMP program is managed locally by the LeSueur County Soil and Water Conservation District and AgStar Farm Credit Services.
