



**American Arborvitae:** (White Cedar) Pyramidal tree grows to 80'. Fast grower and prefers sun to semi-shade and moist wet soils. Tolerant to pruning, will brown in winter.



**Red Cedar:** Prefers well drained soils but will tolerate moderately poor drainage, slow to moderate growth rate. Very good to excellent for wildlife. Intolerant to shade. Mature height: 40-50'.



**Norway Pine:** Native red pine. Fast-growing, long-needed evergreen that needs full sunlight to thrive. Prefers drier, well-drained soils. Mature height: 70'.



**Scotch Pine:** Grayish-yellow branches. Short, rigid, bluish-green needles. Hardy, rapid growing pine. Prefers sandy loams or heavier soils. Will grow on poor ground. Prefers full sun. Mature height: 40'.



**White Pine:** Fast growing with dark green, long needles that keep their color all year. Prefers moist, well drained soil and full to partial sun. Mature height: 90'.



**Black Hills Spruce:** Noted for its dark green foliage and conical form. Prefers heavier soils, full sun, adequate moisture and clean cultivation. Mature height: 40'.



**Norway Spruce:** Planted in moist, rich soil, this is the FASTEST growing of the spruce family. Attractive drooping branches, prefers full sun. Mature height: 90'.

**White Spruce:** Moderately, fast growing, short needled evergreen that grows well in full or partial sunlight. Prefers heavier, more fertile soils. Excellent for windbreaks and winter wildlife cover. Mature height: 60'.



**Techny Arborvitae:** Fast growing, denser foliage than other arborvitae, very hardy. Grows best in full sun to partial shade. Mature height: 15'.



**Ponderosa Pine:** Dark green needles, 5"-8" long. Grows well on drained uplands. Good windbreak tree. Mature height: 80'.



**Bur Oak:** Large, long-lived tree with stout limbs forming broad crown. Excellent tree for wildlife food and cover. Mature height: 70'.



**Hackberry:** The wide spreading branches and light green foliage give this tree an airy appearance. Hardy, rapid growing and not particular as to soil. Bark is corky and rough. Mature height: 80'.



**Pin Oak:** Hard, strong tree with pyramidal shape until mature then turns oval. Fastest growing in the oak family, tolerates wet soils and likes full sun. Mature height: 60-70'.



**Rubrum Maple:** Also known as the Red Maple. The most common maple in North America. Adapts to wide range of conditions. Mature height: 90'.



**Silver Maple:** Fast growing. Graceful form. Will tolerate partial shade. Very hardy. The fall color is gold. Mature height: 75'.



**Siouland Poplar:** Very rapid growth rate. Prefers well drained soils, intolerant to shade. Native to MN. Mature height: 90'.



**Sugar Maple:** Largest of native maples, somewhat slow growing but desirable for symmetrical form and bright fall colors. Very hardy. Prefers well drained soils. Mature height: 70'.



**Red Oak:** Fastest grower of the oaks. Dense, lustrous foliage. Red fall color. Leaves hang on tree into winter. Mature height: 70'.



**Black Walnut:** Tall with deeply fissured brown bark. Important timber tree. Prefers moist, well drained soils. Nuts eaten by squirrels, red and gray fox. Mature height: 85'.



**Redosier Dogwood:** Large, fast growing, many stemmed shrub. White flowers in late spring. Stems turn red in winter, berries are eaten by birds. Tolerant to diverse soil types. Withstand poorly drained soils. Does well in full sun or light shade. Mature height: 10'.



**Purple Lilac:** Prefers loam to sandy soils, needs adequate moisture and prefers full light. Purplish flowers, high quality for wildlife cover. Mature height: 8'.



**Amur Maple:** Multi stemmed, fine to medium textured, large shrub. Leaves are dark green, developing a vivid fall color of yellow to deep red. Requires well drained soil and full sun. Mature height: 18'.



Mature height: 12'.

**Nannyberry:** Attractive shiny foliage, good for wildlife cover. Likes full sun to part shade.
